Mountain Explorers:

(Advanced Intermediate / Expert)

The Mountain Explorers program is for the skier who is interested in improving their skill, while skiing in a supervised group. This non-travel program may compete in non-USSS events hosted and Montage Mountain Resorts. However, this is a skilled based program and not competitive by design. Skier should be able to ski blue square terrain, parallel, and black diamond terrain in good snow conditions.
