VACANCY ANNOUNCEMENT FOR 2025-2026 SKI SEASON: Montage Mountain is seeking qualified part-time & Full Time Alpine Skiing & Snowboard Instructors. You must be age 16 by Dec. 21st or older and available to work approximately 3 shifts per week. We hire High School & College Ages, Adults, Retirees and everyone in between! We are one big family at the Ski & Snowboard School!

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- Age 16 by December 21, 2025
- Strong commitment and desire to teach/instruct Skiing or Snowboarding
- Ability to communicate effectively.
- Intermediate skiing/snowboarding ability
- Need your own Equipment
- Successfully completing the Montage Mountain **Instructor Training Course (ITC)**
- **OR-** already have Level II or III certification with Professional Ski Instructors of America (PSIA)

INSTRUCTOR TRAINING COURSE (ITC): The course consists of 5 days in November and December. It is designed as an instructional learning segment for an instructor position at Montage Mountain if you do not have any certifications in ski or snowboard teaching. Course topics will cover basic ski/snowboard teaching, communication skills, demonstration skills and customer service skills. All candidates successfully completing the Montage Mountain ITC will be interviewed for employment. **You must attend all 5 sessions to pass the course** and qualify to be offered a position.

ITC COURSE: (5 sessions run 8:30 A.M. to 3:30 P.M.)

November 30, Orientation Day
December 7, Indoor &/ or On-snow Training
December 13, Indoor &/or On-snow Training
December 14, On-snow Training
December 20, Evaluation/Graduation Day

Montage Mountain Ski School & Snowboard School Ski & Snowboard Instructors

Job Description: Instructors teach the fundamentals of the sport of alpine skiing or snowboarding to a group and/or individual while actively participating in the sport. The instructor follows the guidelines and directives of the American Teaching System (ATS), Professional Ski Instructors of America (PSIA), American Association of Snowboard Instructors (AASI), and that of the Montage Mountain Ski & Snowboard School. While teaching the sport, the instructor uses teaching skills and knowledge that takes in consideration the student's skiing ability, health, age, and comfort level, along with terrain, equipment, and snow conditions. The goal of the instructor is to maximize a student's enjoyment of the sport by improving their technique and confidence in a fun, safety conscious learning environment. Instructors will learn how to tech and set up their customers with rental equipment. The instructor must demonstrate excellent customer service through these processes.

Wage Compensation: Instructors are paid for the actual time teaching a class session or other assigned duties---Instructors are not paid for time at the area, clinics, free-skiing, etc. The rate per hour of compensation varies depending on experience, PSIA certification level, and number of years teaching at Montage Mountain. **First-year** starting pay is **\$14.00-\$24.00/** hour depending on whether you are teaching Group or Private Lessons.

Qualifications:

- All new candidates not Certified Level II or III must take the Instructor Training Course (ITC) in order to qualify for employment.
- Only PSIA/ AASI Level II or III are waived the requirement of taking the Instructor Training Course. The standard for employment is a Level III PSIA Ski Instructor. If not Level III, in good standing with PSIA, Instructors are asked to improve their qualifications, by attending the training weekend (Mid- December) or clinics after lineups when not assigned a lesson. These clinics are free of charge to all Montage Mountain Instructors.

SCHEDULE AND COMMITMENT:

1. Commitment for Instructors is 3 shifts per week, both Sat & Sun shifts are preferred and one night per week. 2. Local (Part-time) Instructors: (within a 40-mile radius of the mountain) must commit to 32 shifts per season in order to remain on staff and keep skiing / riding privileges.
3. Weekend (Part-time) Instructors (living further than the 40 mile radius of the mountain) must commit to 20 of 30 Sat. & Sun. days.

SATURDAYS & SUNDAYS:

TYPICAL DAY SHIFT

8:30AM – 3:30 PM. There are usually 2-3 Lessons Available for you to teach per shift.

TYPICAL NOON SHIFT

Noon - 8:30PM. There are usually 2-3 Lessons Available for you to teach per shift.

WEEKDAYS Mon - Fri:

DAY SHIFT

Mon – Friday from 8:30AM-4PM. You get paid by the day regardless how many lessons you teach. Please inquire when you submit your application.

TYPICAL NIGHT SHIFT

6:00 P.M. - 8:30 P.M. There is usually only 1 Lesson Available for you to teach per night shift.

E. Uniforms: The Ski Area owns the uniform jackets (Royal Blue Avalanche Jacket). A security deposit will be taken via cash, Check or Credit Card when your uniform jacket is issued to you. When the uniform jacket is returned in good condition you will receive your security deposit back. Black ski pants must be worn with the uniform jacket. Full uniform (including nametag and photo I.D.) is to be worn while at the ski area.
